

To Save an INTERACTIVE Excel Chart as a Web Page

After saving a chart as a Web page, you cannot modify the .htm file in *Excel* without losing functionality. Use *Microsoft FrontPage 2000* or *Microsoft Access 2000* to edit the web page.

1. Click on the chart.
2. On the file menu, click **Save as Web Page**.
3. Click **Publish**.
4. Under Viewing Options, select the **Add Interactivity with check box**. (Chart Functionality is automatically selected.)
5. To add a title, click **Change** and type the title you want. Then click **OK**.
6. In the **File Name box**, click **Browse** and locate the drive, folder, Web server, or FTP location where you want to save your chart.
7. To view you page after you save it, select the **Open published Web page in browser check box**.
8. Click **Publish**.
