

To change the appearance of your mouse pointer

1. Open **Mouse** in Control Panel.
2. On the **Pointers** tab, do one or both of the following:
 - To change all of your pointers at one time, select a new scheme under **Scheme**.
 - To change one pointer, select it in the **Customize** list. Click **Browse**, and then double-click the name of the new pointer you want to use for that task.
- To open Mouse, click **Start**, click **Control Panel**, click **Printers and Other Hardware**, and then click **Mouse**.
- A pointer scheme is any combination of pointers used on your desktop. You can change any number of pointers and then save them as a new scheme by clicking **Save As** under **Scheme**. The new scheme will appear in the list under **Scheme**.
