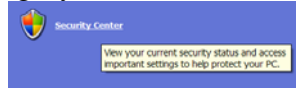


To Set Automatic Updates for Microsoft Windows XP

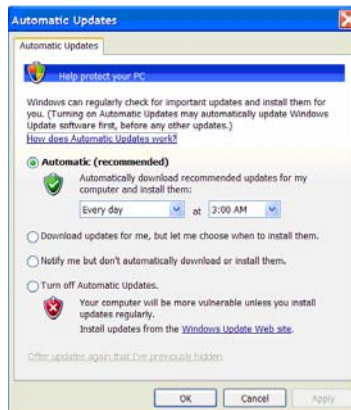
1. Click on **Start**.
2. Click on **Control Panel**.
3. If your computer is set to Category View, click on Security Center.



If your computer is set to Classic View, click on Automatic Updates.



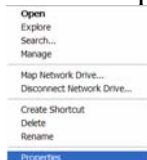
Automatic Updates



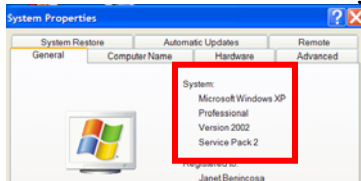
4. Make sure that the top button is selected, so that updates are automatically downloaded and **INSTALLED** every day.

To make sure that Service Pack 2 has been installed on the computer,

Right-Click on My Computer.
Select Properties.



On the General tab of the System Properties box make sure **Service Pack 2** is displayed.



If it is not, you need to download it manually. Open Internet Explorer, click on Tools, and from the drop-down list, click on Windows Update, and follow the directions on the screen.
