A new release incorporates exciting changes, including a **requirement that teachers establish unique user names.**

Users should go to ...

- *Provide his or her individual e-mail address, preferably Access E-mail account.*
- *Create a user name and a password that are case-sensitive, a minimum of six letters and/or numbers and without spaces or punctuation.*

Upon completion of these setup tasks, teachers will receive a verification e-mail at the address provided. **Teachers must click the URL in the verification e-mail within seven days;** otherwise, their personal account information will be deleted and they will need to set up the account again.

After verifying their accounts, teachers should use their personal user names and passwords each time they access Curriculum Pathways. Among the benefits of this personal teacher account is the ability to “flag” or bookmark specific resources for easier retrieval. Teachers also can annotate resources for future reference.

Students should continue to use the single student user name assigned to the school.

New Teacher’s Edition

- **Format:** Students and teachers will now see the materials in the same format.
- **Flags:** By clicking a Flag icon, teachers can attach their own notes to any Curriculum Pathways resource. Not only does the flag make the resource easy to find (like a bookmark), it also ensures that teachers can simultaneously see (and update) their own comments about how and when they intend to use the material. By preserving a busy teacher’s preparatory work and linking it to the source material, flags improve efficiency and eliminate the frustrating question, Why did I save this page?
- **Quick Launch:** Browsing and accessing resources will be easier because teachers will now have the same Quick Launch feature previously available only to students.
- **Dashboard:** Once teachers find an interesting resource, they can use our new dashboard to flag a resource, access content-related standards, view a lesson guide, or access student directions for a resource.
- **Access:** Teachers will now use unique login names and passwords—and be able to retrieve forgotten login information via e-mail. Teachers will use their school’s access information the first time they log in and their personal access information for subsequent logins.

Upgrades
